BOAT STORAGE

DRAFT PROCEDURES

- This draft document has been prepared for discussion and eventual ratification by the Committee of Glencoe Boat Club.

The following is proposed -

- Subject to space being available boats may be stored in the Glencoe Boat Club compound at no charge.
- The maximum weight of vessel to be stored is 1000Kg
- Vessels to be stored must be securely attached to a suitable trailer in order that it may be moved if necessary.
- Prior permission for storage **MUST** be obtained from the Commodore who will also advise as to the deployment of the vessel.
- Members should take particular care when negotiating the access road from the A82.
- Formal storage permission must be renewed annually with the Club Secretary by 31 March. Any vessel which is stored without permission for a period exceeding 6 months will be deemed to have been abandoned and will be disposed of as thought appropriate by the Committee of Glencoe Boat Club.
- Only fully paid up members of Glencoe Boat Club may store their own vessels on the Club's premises.
- Such members will accept full responsibility for their vessel and any consequential damage to their or any other vessel or property.
- Under no circumstances will Glencoe Boat Club accept liability for any damage caused by or to a stored vessel.
- In the event of any dispute with regard to storage, the decision of the Commodore of Glencoe Boat Club will be final.
